Poster guidelines

Please consider the following guidelines when preparing your poster. These are suggestions, not fully mandatory rules.

- Layout and accessibility: Recommended poster size: A0 (841x1189mm)
- Font sizes should be big enough. If in doubts, use larger font.
- If A0 is the selected dimension, fonts and graphics should be approx. 4 times the size than on A4 poster (e.g. titles = 18x4, text 14x4).
- Fonts should be sans-serif (e.g. Verdana).
- Selected colours (if any) should have good contrast.
- Text should not be ALL CAPS (titles are optional).
- There should be some increased spacing between the letters.
- There should be some increased spacing for line-breaks and paragraphs.
- Used images should be exact, without unnecessary details.

Use Plain or Easy Language

Content (cf. <https://guides.nyu.edu/posters>):

- Title is short and draws interest.
- Word count of about 300 to 800 words.
- Text is clear and to the point.
- Use of bullets, numbering, and headlines make it easy to read.
- Consistent and clean layout.
- Include acknowledgments, your name and institutional affiliation.

Print a small version for on-site distribution (A4).
